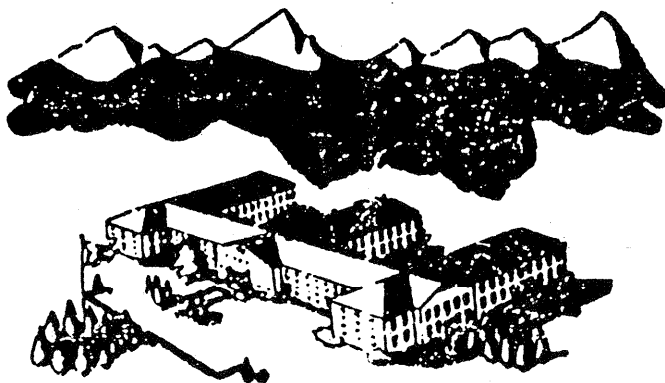

Colonel Charles H. McNary, Commanding Officer, Mr. Arthur A. French, Civilian Personnel Officer, and Mr. Fred P. Goeritz, Deputy Employment Policy Officer, attended a conference held by the President's Committee for Fair Employment Policy, at the Denver Federal Center, 13 July 1962, concerning the carrying out of President Kennedy's Executive Order 10925.

A meeting of the military agencies in the Denver area was held on 10 August 1962, at the Air Force Accounting and Finance Center, in preparation for The 1963 United Fund Campaign. Lt Colonel Albert H. Beck, Deputy Commander, and Mr. Michael A. Pasquariello, Acting Chairman, Rocky Mountain Arsenal Fund Raising Committee, represented the Arsenal. Major General Paul W. Scheidecker, in charge of the Military Section for the 1963 drive, briefly outlined methods to be followed in achieving the goals of the individual agencies and the need for all to attain 100% or more of their goal. The quote for RMA in the 1963 drive is \$4,030.00. The Arsenal contributed \$3,631.58 in the 1962 drive. The 1963 drive extends from 25 September 1962 through 1 November 1962.

Major General Paul W. Scheidecker, Commanding General, Air Force Accounting and Finance Center, Denver, accompanied by nine military and civilian members of his staff, visited the Arsenal 27 August 1962. They were given a briefing of Arsenal operations, including the Army Industrial Fund, current programs, manufacturing facilities, and the deep disposal well. Upon conclusion of the briefing, they were taken on a conducted tour of the M55 Rocket Line, the MC-1 Massive Bomb Line, and the Hydrazine blending facility.

On 27 August 1962, thirty members of the Naval Reserve Intelligence Division 9-1, Unit 11, Denver, Colorado, visited the Arsenal for the purpose of receiving an orientation and guided tour of Arsenal operations. They were conducted on a tour of the M55 Line, MC-1 Line, Deep Disposal Well, and Hydrazine facility.

From 6 to 10 September 1962, Japan Group I-63 visited Rocky Mountain Arsenal. They were briefed on Arsenal activities and were conducted on an orientation tour. The group consisted of: Major General Fujio SATO, Deputy Commandant, Fuji School; Major General Teruto KUNITAKE, DCS, Western Army Headquarters; Colonel Hideo TOYAMA, Chemical Chief, Chemical Section, Ground Staff Office; Mr. Taisaku FURUHATA, JDA-3, Japan Defense Agency; and Major Tomomi ANDO, U. S. Army, who served as tour director and interpreter.

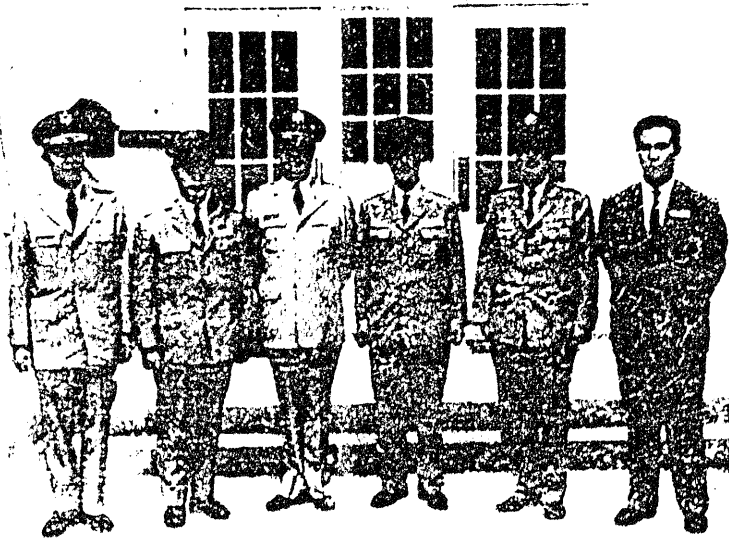

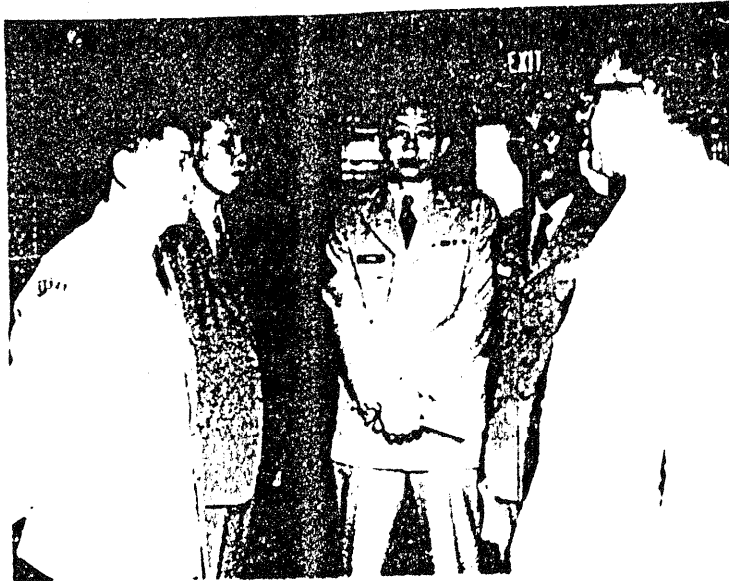
